

## **IMPORTED FIRE ANT AREAS IN TENNESSEE QUARANTINED AREAS FOR YEAR 2010**

1. **Anderson County** – That portion of the county lying southeast of a line beginning at the Morgan/Anderson County line on Tennessee Highway 330 and then continuing northeast along Tennessee Highway 330 until reaching Tennessee Highway 116 and then continuing north along Tennessee Highway 116 until reaching Interstate 75 and then that portion of the county lying southwest of Interstate 75 while continuing southeast along Interstate 75 until reaching the Anderson/Knox County line.

12. **Cumberland County** – That portion of the county lying southeast of a line beginning at the White/Cumberland County line on United States Highway 70 and then continuing east along United States Highway 70 until reaching United States

Highway 127 and then continuing north along United States Highway 127 until reaching the Cumberland/Fentress County line.

13. **Davidson County** - *That portion of the county lying south of the Cumberland River.*

15. **Dickson County** – That portion of the county lying south of a line beginning at the Humphreys/Dickson County line on United States Highway 70 and then continuing east along United States Highway 70 until reaching Tennessee Highway 96 and then continuing southeast along Tennessee Highway 96 until reaching the Dickson/Williamson County line.
16. **Fayette County** – The entire county.

18. **Gibson County** – That portion of the county lying southeast of a line beginning at the Madison/Gibson County line on United States Highway 45 W and then continuing northwest along United States Highway 45 W until reaching the United States Highway 45 W Bypass (Tennessee Highway 366) and then continuing north along the United States Highway 45 W Bypass until reaching United States Highway 45 W and then continuing north along United States Highway 45 W until reaching Tennessee Highway 54 and then continuing northeast along Tennessee Highway 54 until reaching Tennessee Highway 105 and then continuing east along Tennessee Highway 105 until reaching the Gibson/Carroll County line.
19. **Giles County** – The entire county.

28. **Knox County** – That portion of the county lying southwest of a line beginning at the Union/Knox County line on Tennessee Highway 33 and then continuing south along Tennessee Highway 33 until reaching North Hall of Fame Drive and then continuing southeast along North Hall of Fame Drive until reaching Interstate 40 and then continuing east along Interstate 40 until reaching Midway Road and then continuing south along Midway Road until reaching Smith School Road and then continuing southeast along Smith School Road until reaching Dave Smith Road and then continuing east along Dave Smith Road until reaching the Knox/Sevier County line.
29. **Lauderdale County** – *That portion of the county lying southwest of a line beginning at the Mississippi County, Arkansas/Lauderdale County, Tennessee line at Latitude 35 Degrees 45 Minutes and then continuing east along Latitude 35 Degrees 45 Minutes until reaching Tennessee Highway 19 and then continuing east along Tennessee Highway 19 until reaching United States Highway 51 and then continuing south along United States Highway 51 until again reaching Tennessee Highway 19 and then continuing east along Tennessee Highway 19 until reaching the Lauderdale/Haywood County line.*
